- 1) An African-American poet in the 1700s
- 2) Influential in getting women the right to vote
- 3) Author of *Uncle Tom's Cabin*
- 4) An Underground Railroad "conductor" who led many slaves to freedom
- 5) Founded the American Red Cross
- 6) Credited with saving a portrait of George Washington when the White House burned in 1814
- 7) Author of *Little Women*
- 8) Beloved teacher who introduced language to her blind and deaf student

### Down

- 1) Refused to give up her seat on a bus in 1955 and sparked the modern civil rights movement
- 2) Assisted Lewis and Clark on their expedition
- 3) First woman nominated to the United States Supreme Court
- 4) Blind lyricist of many hymns still sung in churches today
- 5) First colonial American woman to be published
- 6) Folk artist popular for depicting rural life in the United States during the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries
- 7) First African-American Metropolitan Opera star
- 8) First woman to fly solo over the Atlantic Ocean
